COMPETITION RULES

- The competition is open to accordion chamber ensembles (2 to 9 players) with any instrumental lineup the accordion must be included.
- Participants may be students of elementary music schools, conservatories, or universities from any country.
- The average age of the ensemble members is calculated on the competition date (March 14, 2026).
- The repertoire is optional, but genre and stylistic variety are recommended.
- In the case of mixed duos, the piece must have a chamber character, with equally demanding parts. A teacher or professional musician is not allowed to perform on the second instrument only students may participate.
- The jury reserves the right to stop a performance that exceeds the time limit.
- The quality of arrangements and the suitability of the repertoire will be evaluated as part of the performance.
- In case of a large number of applications, the organizers reserve the right to close registration early or split categories based on instrumentation.

CATEGORIES:

Category 0	age average under 8 years	time limit: 3–5 minutes
Category 1	age average under 10 years	time limit 5–8 min
Category 2	age average up to 13 years	time limit: 8–10 minutes
Category 3	age average under 15 years	time limit: 10–12 minutes
Category 4	age average under 21 years	time limit: 12–15 minutes

How to calculate the average age:

- 1. Add up the age of all ensemble members as of March 14, 2026.
- 2. Divide the total by the number of members.
- 3. Round the result to one decimal place.
